

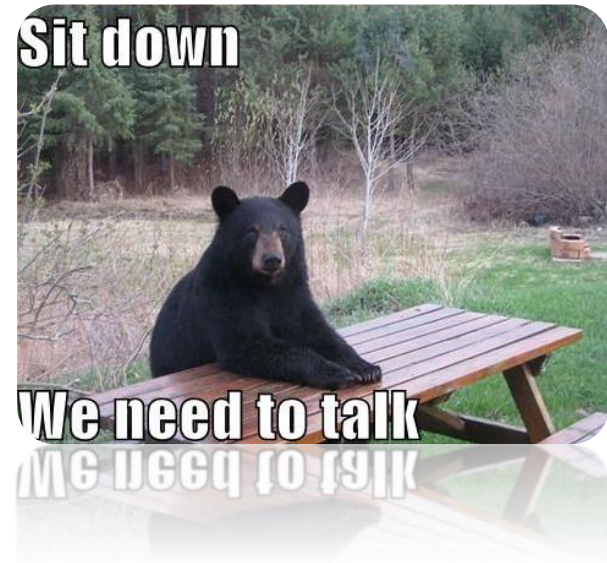


# Welcome to Chellaston Junior School



Good and effective home school communication is a very important part of achieving the best possible learning outcomes for your child



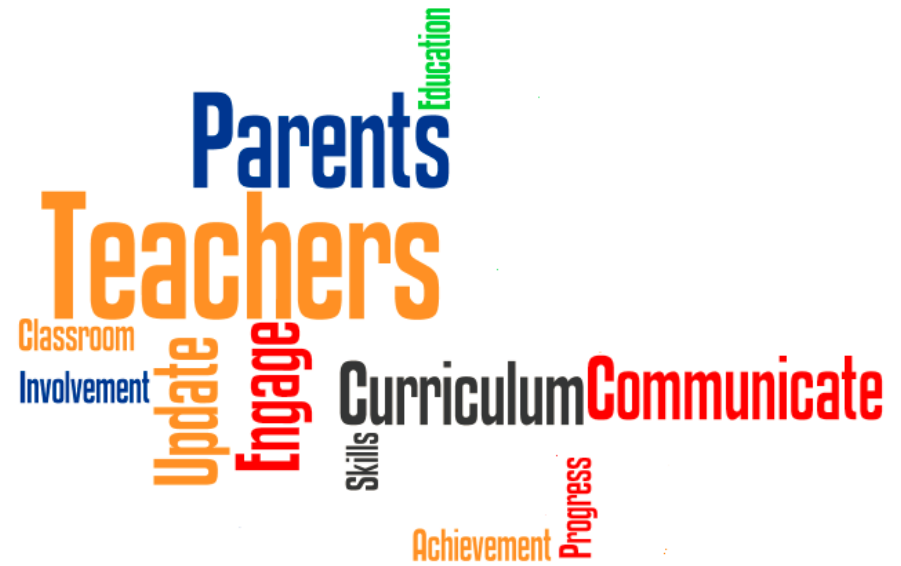


- ▶ Staff are happy to talk to you at any time regarding your child.

- ▶ Coffee mornings - come and meet other parents. Talk to our Learning Mentor and healthcare professionals

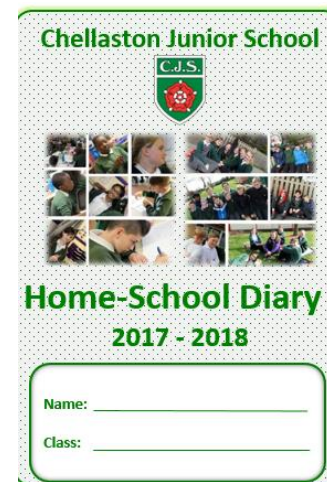

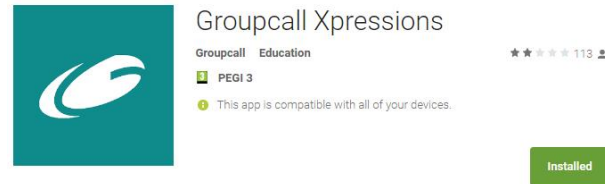
