

Celebrating CJS at 50



We are going to create a lasting memory of CJS turning 50 and you are all invited to make your mark.

We will each be painting a stone which will be laid to form a path. As the stones will be varnished, to protect them from the weather, the path will be a lasting record of everyone who makes CJS such a special place in this year.

We need your help!

Please bring into school a stone to paint. It needs to be as big as your hand (around 15cm long) and be clean, smooth and ready to paint.

If you can find more than one – bring them in, we need as many as possible by Friday.



Step 1

Decide what type of design you would like to create.

Remember only the top of the stone will be seen.

Step 2

Get painting!

You can start your design straight away or you may want to paint your stone a base colour first.



Step 3

Add more detail by layering up colours. Just make sure each layer of paint is dry before you add the next one.



Step 4

Leave your stone to completely dry and we will varnish it for you.
