Year 5 & 6 Parent Lunches

(Year 5 – 19 & 26 April and Year 6 – 13 & 27 June and 4 July)

This term we welcome parents from Year 5 and Year 6 for parent lunches. We send out a text message to parents a couple of weeks in advance to inform them when places are available to book (Year 5 parents' lunches are already 'live' on ParentPay).

Year 6 SATs

Week commencing 14 May

There will be information going out to Year 6 parents shortly to outline the arrangements for SATs week.

Years 3, 4 & 5 Assessment Weeks

Weeks commencing 21st May and 4th June

During the week commencing 21st May and 4th June, the pupils will be undertaking some assessments in reading, writing and maths. It is important that all pupils attend school during this time, if at all possible, as the assessments will help to inform the overall teacher assessment for the year, which will be included in the end of year reports sent out to parents in July.

Year 6 Activity Week Meeting

Tuesday 22nd May at 6.00 pm

This meeting is for **ALL** parents of Year 6 pupils. Some pupils will be going on the Year 6 Residential to Abernant Lakes and others have chosen to take part in three Activity Days. The meeting will cover all the arrangements for the week; parents and pupils are invited to attend.

PTFA Discos

Thursday 24th May

We will continue to run the discos as we have this year. There will be three separate discos:-

5.00 – 6.00 pm, 6.15 – 7.15 pm and 7.30 – 8.30 pm, which can be booked on ParentPay. All three discos will be open to any pupils from Years 3, 4, 5 or 6.
