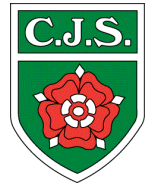

The after school cricket club is open to pupils from Years 3, 4 5 & 6. Mr Emery and Mr Gadsby will also be helping out at the club. The cost is only £1 per week and can be booked via Parent Pay.

Prompt start to the school day

We ask that all pupils come through the school gates before 8.55 am in the morning. We aim for all children to be in class and ready to start the day's learning by 8.55 am and thank parents for ensuring that children are here on time and have a good start to the day.

Parent Governor

Information was sent out to parents last term regarding vacancies for Parent Governors here at CJS. The closing date was originally Friday 13th April, so if anyone is interested I would welcome the opportunity to discuss the role with you. Please

don't feel you need extensive qualifications for the role; we need parents with a range of skills who are enthusiastic about supporting the work of the school. Due to the Easter holiday period, we would like to extend the deadline to next Friday, 20th April.

Building Work

Work has begun to extend the school hall and car park. As you can see the car park is taking shape and the foundations for the hall are now being dug. The project is planned to finish at the start of July. Access to the external hall door will not be available during this time, so parents are asked to come to the school office at all times. We are working with the contractors to ensure that there is a minimum of disruption to the school day. We will keep parents informed as the project progresses.

Academy Update

Following the feedback to parents from the consultation process, the four schools in Chellaston have submitted application forms to become a Multi-Academy Trust. The applications will be considered by the office of the Regional Schools Commissioner and we will be notified in due course if our application has been successful. We will keep parents informed as the term progresses.

Water Bottles

A reminder to all parents that we very much encourage all pupils to bring water to school each day to keep hydrated. Pupils have the opportunity to fill their water bottles at certain times during the school day. Please note that it is the school policy to allow only plain water for drinking during the school day. Children are allowed to bring juice for packed lunches or after school clubs if they so wish.

Term Time Holidays

We would like to remind all parents that absence around INSET Days, half terms and holidays will not be authorised if the school has reason to believe that parents are extending their holidays by taking their children out of school during this time. If the school have information that this may be the case, then we will ask for evidence of the holiday dates

before we will authorise the absence for any other reason.

School Uniform

Clothing 4 will be supplying all Chellaston Junior School uniform in line with other Chellaston schools. Our stock has been transferred to their new store on the High Street and is no longer available through ParentPay.
