


# Chellaston Junior School

Dear Parents,

Year 4 classes will be visiting the Sikh Temple in Derby as part of the R.E. theme studying different places of worship. Pupils will have an opportunity to look around all areas of the temple and follow a faith trail to compare their experience with other places of worship they have previously visited.

The dates for the visits are as follows:-

Wednesday, 13<sup>th</sup> June – Chatsworth and Glossop

Thursday, 14<sup>th</sup> June – Duffield and Foremark

The cost of this visit will be £5.20 which should be made via your ParentPay account. All schools now receive extra cash for every child registered as eligible for free school meals (FSM) at any point in the past six years and children in care who have been looked after for six months. Therefore, if your child qualifies in either of these categories, you need only pay £2.60 towards the cost of this visit - please contact the school if you are unsure whether you qualify.

ParentPay have recently introduced a 'Trips Module' which will enable us to collect all the information we need from parents to manage our school visits. This will include parental consent, emergency contact details and any other specific information.

The children will travel by coach to and from the Sikh Temple in the morning, returning to school before lunch. As a sign of respect, the children will need to bring a headscarf (not baseball style caps or woolly hats) to cover their heads and wear trousers. If you don't have a headscarf, a square of material that can be tied over the head would be sufficient.

During their visit to the Sikh Temple, pupils may be given an opportunity to taste a small sample of traditional foods. One of the health and safety requirements of this is that we know of any allergies your child may have to any foods. You will need to provide this information when you log on to ParentPay and give your consent. If you do not declare any allergies, your child will take part in the food tasting sessions.
